NB: Both FTTP and SoGEA require a VoIP telephony product (see next step) to continue to make and receive voice calls.

Add a some great connectivity; either FTTP, leased line or SoGEA, depending on your business requirements. We have provided an overview of FTTP and SoGEA to help you make your decision.

FTTP

Fibre to the Premises (FTTP) is a broadband technology that can provide very fast internet speeds.

Pros:

- Very fast broadband - up to 1Gbps download speed, with the capacity to go even faster
- Fast upload and download speed
- Doesn't require a phone line rental

Cons:

- Availability is currently very limited
- Serviced with lower speeds are cheaper

SoGEA

Single Order Generic Ethernet Access (SoGEA) allows you to place one order with one supplier for your broadband data service.

Pros:

- Affordable broadband at various speeds
- Available everywhere
- Great for home-working
- Doesn't require a phone line rental

Cons:

- Speed is limited to <100Mbps - plenty for most micro businesses
